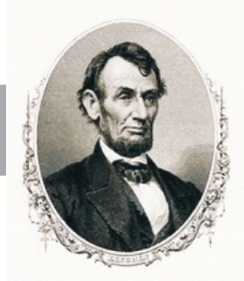

**ABRAHAM LINCOLN'S
LETTER
TO THE HEADMASTER - A WORD TO TEACHERS**

Respected Teacher,

“He will have to learn, I know, that all men are not just and are not true. But teach him if you can, the wonder of books..but also give him quiet time to ponder the eternal mystery of birds in the sky, bees in the sun and flowers on a green hillside. In school, teach him it is far more honorable to fall than to cheat.

Teach to have faith in his own ideas, even if everyone tells him he is wrong. Teach him to be gentle with gentle people and tough with the tough. Try to give my son the strength not to follow the crowd when everyone getting on the bandwagon.

Teach him to listen to all men; but teach him also to filter all he hears on a screen of truth, and take only the good that comes through. Teach him, if you can, how to laugh when he is sad... Teach him there is no shame in tears. Teach him to scoff at cynics and to beware of too much sweetness.

Teach him to sell his brawn and brain to highest bidders, but never to put a price on his heart and soul. Teach him to close his ears to a howling mob..and stand and fight if thinks he is right. Treat him gently, but do not cuddle him, because only the test of fire makes one steel. Let him have the courage to be impatient.

Let him have the patience to be brave. Teach him always to have sublime faith in himself, because then he will have faith in humankind. This is a big order, but see what you can do. He is such a fine little fellow, my son!

We believe that every child is unique and an effort is made to cater to his / her individuality .Multiple intelligence being the need of the hour,of different approach is adopted to take care of the children. Above all, the focus is to mould every child from BPPS to be a responsible citizen of the world, with Strong fundamentals and deep rooted values ,to see them through the challenges of life. with the great efforts and inspiration of Hon. Ambadas (Anna) Balaji Bankar and Hon. Madhavrao Balaji Bankar BPPS' commenced from academic year 2017-18. We believe, School should be a place where a child loves to be in and not where he / she dreads to go.

Staff-The Staff members are educated , competent and highly Qualified and dedicated to the profession.

Academic Session- The academic session of the school starts from April and ends in March.

Recommendation to Parents:-

- 1)Parents are integral part of the school and the school expects them to co-operate in enforcing all the guidelines that will benefit the child and assist in the smooth functioning of the school .
- 2)The calendar serves as a bridge between teachers ,students and parents .Parents are requested to sign the remarks written by the teachers in the school calendar . Also please sign in the ' Record of Circulars sent ' on page no. 32 / 33 as & when the circular is sent .
- 3)Parents can use the calendar to communicate with the teachers regarding their child's academics or behavior .All other matters should be addressed to the Principal .
- 4)The school insists on strict punctuality ,regular school attendance , regulation regarding uniform,cleanliness in dress good grooming and fidelity to study and work assignments
Absence from school for merely social functions is discouraged .

- 5) As the medium of instructions in the school is English , parents should provide ample opportunities to their children to converse in English at home .
- 6) Parents need to check that their ward does not carry a mobile phone to school . In case of emergencies the school phone / land line to be used by students .
- 7) If a student is found carrying a mobile phone or any other electronic device , it will be confiscated and a fine of Rs . 500/- will be imposed . The mobile will be returned only in the month of March .
- 8) Parents are requested to encourage their ward to take a balanced interested in academics , co- curricular activities and sports .
- 9) Parents are advised to strictly avoid criticism of school and school teachers in the presence of the ward,as it may lead to loss of respect for the school /school teachers which may in turn lead to failure to learn from him/her ,resulting in lack of ward's progress .

General School Rules

- Every student is expected to carry the school almanac to school every day .
- Students are expected to move in the corridors and stairs in a disciplined manner .They will walk in a line in perfect silence at all times .
- Students who commute to school by their own conveyance must be in school by 8.40 am , school gates will close at 8.45 am . Students who report late to school will be sent back home.
- Students are refrain from bringing any sharp object to school .
- Students are not to carry mobiles /electronic gadgets to school and while traveling in the school bus .
- Students who use offensive language ,bully & hurt other students or cause damage to school property are liable to be penalized .
- Students are permitted to wear coloured clothes on the occasion of birthdays .Students across all grades may distribute chocolates to their class , however only 'Original Brand 'of chocolates is allowed .
- Students should take pride in keeping the school clean.
- Teachers are not to be presented with gifts on any occasions .
- Tattoos of any kind are strictly prohibited .
- Uniform is compulsory during school hours and for all school functions including all such instances where students are representing the school outside.
- The school reserves the right to terminate the continuance of students with unsatisfactory progress in studies or whose conduct is unexemplary for others.
- Students must not leave the school premises without their nominated escort. In case of a delay in the arrival of such escorts, they should report the matter to the school office.
- Students are expected to carry books and notebooks in strict accordance with the time table and refrain from bringing unnecessary material to school.
- The school is committed to protecting the environment and expects its students to be environment friendly in all their actions.
- The School issues newsletters / Notices from time to time for all important communications through students. Parents are responsible for checking up with the children regularly for news from school.
- All the books have to be neat and clean till the end of the session. Scribbling, tearing or misuse of books will not be accepted.
- Students have to be present on all the last working days and the reopening days after a short or long vacation.

Recommendations to Parents about School Transport

Our school provides transport facility to its students. Student can avail school buses, subjects to the availability of seats. The routes followed by the buses will be drawn up well in advance and the parents should consult the campus incharge for the necessary details.

School Bus Rules

- 1.No student will be allowed to travel by bus without school identity card.
- 2.Students using the school bus are expected to be at the bus stop, at least 5 minutes before the arrival time of the bus.
- 3.The buses will not wait for any late comers.
- 4.Students should stay away from the main road and approach the bus only when it comes to a complete halt.
- 5.Parents should accompany the child to board & alight the school bus.
- 6.All students must occupy seats immediately after boarding their buses.
- 7.The drivers are authorized to stop the buses at the designated stops only, unless otherwise directed by the bus teacher. The list of stops is prepared keeping in view the convenience and safety of all bus commuters and is subject to change.

No diversion / extension will be entertained on existing routes.

- 8.When the bus is in motion, students must sit on their seat and refrain from leaning out, peeping out or standing on the footboard or on the seats.
- 9.Students will be held responsible for any damage to the bus caused by negligence or vandalism.
- 10.Unruly behavior like shrieking and shouting inside the bus is strictly prohibited.
- 11.Any change in bus timings will be informed BY SMS service.

ACADEMICS

Classes: Nursery-LKG- UKG

The academic year is divided into two terms. However, evaluation of the child's progress is done on the basis of day to day performance under the Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE). These theme-based assessments are carried out in various ways which include written assessments via worksheets and written work done in the notebooks in school and at home, oral assessments via classroom discussions and interactions, and activity assessments that are judged primarily through Saturday Activities, project activities, Learning Centre activities, creative work, etc. Progress Reports are given to parents thrice in a session during the Open House at the end of each assessment.

Classes I to VII :

What is a Periodic assessment Pattern ?

This assessment consists 4 evaluation in the academic year. The periodic 1 and 3 will be of 20 marks written assessment based on the syllabus. The marks obtained out of 20 shall be converted into 10. The PA-1 will be based on subjective (70%) and objective (30%) type questions. The periodic 2 and 4 will be an internal yet effective assessment based on 2 parameters mainly. The notebook audit will have weightage of 10 marks for each subject and the project based assessment will be of 10 marks during the given dates. The projects will be based on the texts taught and explained in the class.

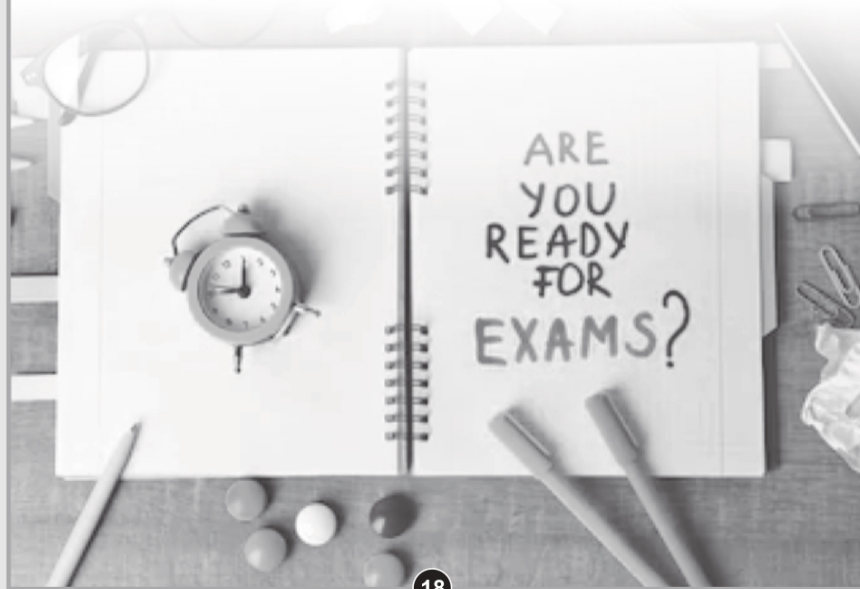
How can assessment in projects assist students ?

A project is a task assigned to an individual or a group to develop basic understanding, practical skills, wholesome interest and desired attitudes among students. Personal and social qualities like leadership, co-operation, resourcefulness, communication skills, organizational skills etc. can be easily assessed through group projects. Parameters such as presentation, creative ability, creative inputs and level of understanding may be used for assessment of projects. The Term assessment 1 and 2 will be of 80 marks for grade 6 to 8. The Term assessment of grade 1 to 5 will be of 60 marks converted in to 30 marks.

Rules for Assessment :

- Attendance is compulsory for all assessments held during the year, failing which the student will be given a zero. Consideration what so ever will be only on genuine medical grounds. However this is upon the sole discretion of the Head of School after the parents personally meet and submit an application with the photocopies of all relevant medical documents on the day of the exam at the school office during school hours.
- There is no provision of appearing in FA and then leave the school for home on medical/ personal grounds. Taking the child back home after assessment(s) will be treated as absence for the day.
- A minimum attendance record of 90% of the total number of working days in each term/ unit is compulsory. In the eventuality of a student missing classes due to health reasons, the school will have the sole discretion in deciding waiver, if any. But even on medical grounds, absence beyond 20% of working days will not be accepted.
- There is no provision for reassessing students, who remain absent on the day of the assessment, or those who have failed in one or more subjects. Request for change in assessment dates or timings will not be accepted.
- Students reporting late for assessment will not be given any extra time for answering the question papers. Unfair Means: Students found using any unfair means during assessments, will be given zero in that subject.

- Parents and the concerned student will be called for a dialogue with the school authorities. A repeat of such action in future will result in the prompt issue of a Transfer Certificate, without notice.
- Errors in evaluation, such as mistakes in totaling, unmarked answers, etc., must be brought to the notice of the concerned teachers on the same day itself. Delaying this for even one day may result in ignoring the same while preparing the final result.
- Requests for the issue of Progress Report before the declaration of results will not be entertained. A duplicate of Report Card (if lost/damaged) shall be issued on a payment of R 100. An Affidavit and copy of FIR along with the application is a must.

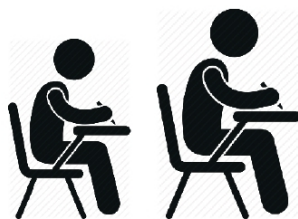
